This form should not be used where a placer location notice, tunnel site location notice, or mill site location notice is required.

Markings—A post must be not less than four inches in diameter, or a stone monument must be at least eighteen inches high.

Witnesses are optional and are not required.

Section 2304, Public Resources Code, reads in part as follows: "(a) Within 90 days after the date of location of any lode mining . . . claim hereafter located, the locator or locators thereof shall sink a discovery shaft upon the claim to a depth of at least 10 feet from the lowest part of the rim of the shaft at the surface, or shall drive a tunnel, adit, or open cut upon the claim to at least 10 feet below the surface . . ."

A location of a lode mining claim is null and void unless such discovery work is duly performed and a true copy of location notice recorded within ninety (90) days from date of location.

This standard form covers most usual problems in the field indicated. Before you sign, read it, fill in all blanks, and make changes proper to your transaction. Consult a lawyer if you doubt the form's fitness for your purpose.
