

In consideration of the Premium stated above and subject to the Conditions endorsed hereon and on the back hereof the Company will pay to the Insured named above (or in the event of the death of the Insured to the Insured's legal personal representative) the sum or sums of money herein specified if the Insured shall sustain any bodily injury caused by violent accidental external and visible means whilst being carried as a fare-paying passenger in or whilst in such capacity entering or descending from any fully licensed standard type Aircraft owned and/or operated by the above named Air Line during the flight specified above which injury independent of any other cause shall result in the Insured's:—

DEFINITIONS.

1. Loss of a limb shall mean the loss of a hand or a foot by physical severance at or above the wrist or ankle.
2. Loss of an eye shall mean total and irrecoverable loss of all sight of one eye.
3. Temporary total disablement shall mean disablement by reason solely of the injury necessarily immediately and continuously resulting in incapacity from attending to business, profession or occupation of any and every kind or, if the Insured has no business, profession or occupation, in confinement to the house and prevention from attending to usual duties (if any).
4. Temporary partial disablement shall mean incapacity by reason solely of the injury from attending to some material part of usual business, profession or occupation.

PROVIDED ALWAYS THAT:—

1. No compensation shall be payable under Sections (a) to (d) unless the death or loss takes place within 90 days after the date of the bodily injury.
2. Compensation under Sections (e) (i) and/or (ii) in respect of any one injury shall not be payable for more than 52 weeks from the commencement of the disablement.
3. Compensation shall be payable under one only of Sections (a) to (e) in respect of any one accident except that the Insured shall be entitled to receive compensation under Section (e) (ii) in succession to a period under Section (e) (i).
4. The total liability of the Company under this Ticket shall in no circumstances exceed the Capital Sum Insured hereunder.

I hereby agree to accept this Ticket subject to all the Terms Conditions and Exceptions printed and endorsed on it, and I hereby warrant that I am in good health, of sound constitution, free from physical infirmity or defect and over sixteen and under sixtyfive years of age and further that I have no other Insurance covering the risks of Accidental Death or Bodily Injury, except as endorsed hereon and that no Insurer has declined this or any similar insurance.

The Insured is requested to read the conditions of this Ticket. If any error or misdescription be found the Ticket should be returned to the Issuing Branch or Agency for correction.

CONDITIONS.

1. No claim shall be payable unless this Ticket has been signed in ink or indelible pencil by the Insured and by an authorised representative of the Company.
2. Upon the happening of any accident likely to give rise to a claim under this Ticket written notice shall be given to the nearest Local Branch or Agency of the Company as soon as possible after the happening of the accident but in any event within three calendar months after the occurrence of the injury in respect of which a claim is made under this Ticket.
3. All certificates information and evidence required by the Company shall be furnished at the expense of the Claimant.
4. The Company shall not be liable in respect of death or disablement directly or indirectly caused by arising from or traceable to:—
 - (a) War Invasion Act of Foreign Enemy Hostilities (whether War be declared or not) Riot Civil Commotion Mutiny Civil War Rebellion Revolution Insurrection or Military or Usurped Power.
 - (b) Suicide or attempted suicide (whether felonious or not) or self injury or a deliberate self exposure to unnecessary danger.
 - (c) Any accident occurring whilst the Insured is in a state of insanity or is under the influence of intoxicating liquor or of any drug.
 - (d) The omission or failure of the Insured to comply with any order or instructions of the Pilot or other officials of the Air Line.
5. The total liability of the Company under this Ticket and any similar Ticket or Policy issued to the Insured by the Company shall not in any event exceed the sum of £10,000 or its equivalent in local currency.
6. All differences as to the amount of the Company's liability under this Ticket shall be referred to the arbitration of a person to be appointed by both parties, or, if they cannot agree upon a single Arbitrator, to the decision of two Arbitrators, one to be appointed in writing by each party, and in case of disagreement between the Arbitrators, to the decision of an Umpire who shall have been appointed in writing by the Arbitrators before entering on the reference, and an award by such Arbitrator, Arbitrators or Umpire of the amount of the Company's liability shall be a condition precedent to any right of action against the Company.
7. In no case whatever shall the Company be liable in respect of any claim after the expiration of 12 months from the date of the accident unless the claim is the subject of pending court action or arbitration.
