You probably cannot remember me. Perhaps you recall an interview in the Grand Hotel, Göteborg, Sweden? That was a few years ago. I met you at Copenhagen at the World Congress and later called at your office in New York. That was four years ago when I was on my way out to China. I have been there under the Reds until Sept. 13th. when I was thrilled to enjoy freedom again.

I am taking the liberty of enclosing an article about the general missionary situation out there. I have not gone into any details, because that would make it easy for the Communists to check up and create difficulties for individuals or churches. I think it is time for our people in the West to know the truth about the actual situation.

I have not received any copies of Missions for a long time. My sister, Miss Edith Rinell, Children's Hospital, 1720 Bainbridge St., Philadelphia 46, Pa., has ordered it directly or through the Baptist Book Store there.
